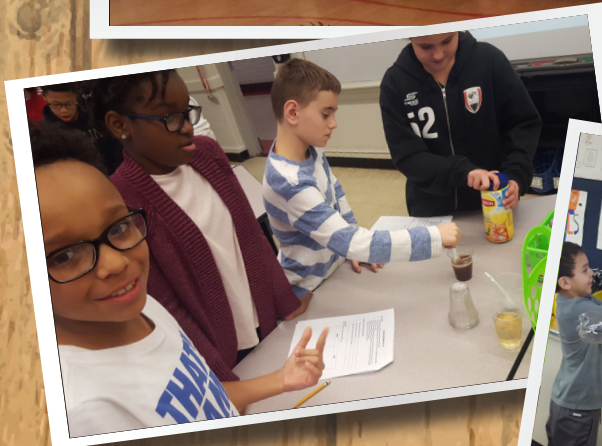

MAYWOOD DOLPHIN SWIM TEAM REGISTRATION



The Maywood Dolphins Swim Team is a not for profit team competing out of the Maywood Municipal Pool. The goal of the team is to provide an environment where children can get physically fit while learning and improving the four competitive swim strokes. The season begins after the close of school in June and continues to the end of July or beginning of August, depending on the level of success each individual swimmer achieves. The swim season is capped with a team party complete with food, games and award recognitions.

New swimmers are always welcome to get in on the fun. The swim team is open to swimmers ages 5 to 17. Practices are weekday mornings prior to regular hours of operation. Swim meets are held in the evenings or on Saturday mornings. In order to become a team member, swimmers must be members of the Maywood Pool and pass a minimum skills swim test.

The registration fee for the swim team is \$15 per swimmer with a \$35 maximum per family. An additional late fee of \$10 per swimmer with a \$20 maximum per family will be charged after Tuesday, June 26, 2018. Volunteers are key in any organization, and in order to fulfill the need for volunteers at swim meets, each family will also be required to submit a separate \$100 "volunteer" deposit. This deposit will be refunded when the volunteer commitment has been satisfied. If you choose not to volunteer, the \$100 will become part of the team's general funds. Checks for the registration fee and volunteer deposit should be made payable to the "Maywood Swim Team". MAYWOOD SUMMER CLUB & SUMMER THEATER CLUB REGISTRATION



Maywood Summer Club provides a full day program for children entering Kindergarten – 8th Grade. The program runs for 8 weeks beginning Monday, June 25, 2018 and ends Friday, August 17, 2018. Regular hours are 8:30am-3pm with available aftercare 3:15pm-6pm. The resident rate for the full program (8 weeks) is \$750, \$100 weekly and aftercare \$75 weekly. The non-resident full program (8 weeks) is \$1,000, \$125 weekly and aftercare \$100. Participants are dropped off at the Maywood Municipal Pool every morning except Wednesday for supervised swim while the pool is closed to the public. Counselors will coordinate Maywood Dolphin Swim Team practice and swim lessons (separate fee). Afternoons are spent at either Maywood Avenue School (weeks 1-6) or Memorial School (weeks 7 & 8). Aftercare is located at the Senior Recreation Center (weeks 1-8). Wednesdays are trip days and participants should be dropped off and picked up at Maywood Avenue School (weeks 1-6) or Memorial School (weeks 7 & 8).

This Spring, be sure to take advantage of our Museum Pass program, and treat your family to an experience they won't forget, using the library's museum passes. GARAGE SALES



With the nice weather here, you may want to consider having a garage sale. Having a garage sale is a great way to "let go" of excess items in your home. Don't forget to get a permit for your sale and follow the following rules:

- Only use signs provided by the Borough to advertise your sale
- No more than two garage sales per calendar year
- Sales are limited to the hours of 9am – 6pm
- Two consecutive day limit for each sale
- Signs must be removed 24 hours after end of last sale day
- Must purchase and display the \$10 garage sale permit

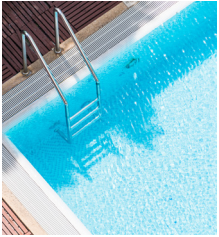
BUILDING PERMITS

- Construction permits are required for:
- Interior renovations
- Building a deck
- Installing a patio, fence or shed
- Replacing your roof, siding, steps, driveway or sidewalk

Any change of ownership or tenancy requires a continued certificate of occupancy. Dumpsters/PODS placed on your property or on Borough property require a permit. All permit applications are available on the Borough website (www.maywoodnj.com) or at 15 Park Avenue, 3rd floor.

METAL & APPLIANCE RECYCLING STICKERS



Large metal goods/appliances such as washers, dryers, refrigerators, air conditioners, heaters, etc. will be picked up by individual schedule. STIGMA FREE ZONE

One in four adults experiences a diagnosable mental illness every year, and many of these individuals do not seek help because of fear of shame or judgment from friends, family or coworkers. Maywood has taken the first steps toward eliminating the stigma associated with mental illness. The elimination of mental health stigma will allow residents to get the resources they need without judgment.

Mayor Febre along with Members of the Council passed a resolution designating the municipality a Stigma-Free Zone in order to create an environment in which residents will feel free to seek treatment for the disease of mental illness without the fear of being stigmatized. Maywood joins Bergen County in declaring itself a Stigma-Free Zone.

Maywood's Municipal Alliance hopes to raise awareness of the disease of mental illness, provide an effective way to reduce the stigma associated with the disease and encourage those who are affected to seek services and feel supported. The establishment of this Stigma-Free Zone will raise awareness of local mental health resources so no one resident needs to feel hopeless or alone. The elimination of stigma will enable residents to ask for help when needed so that recovery can begin, hope is inspired and tragedies are avoided.
